Disciplinary Action and Fines Policy



1. Key Principles and Objectives

All members must observe the Laws of the Game, the FFV Constitution, Regulations, Rules of Competition, Statutes and Regulations, By-Laws and Policies and ensure that the game of football is played competitively and fairly in accordance with principles of true sportsmanship and in accordance with these Laws.

2. Fines and Penalties

All members will be personally liable for any disciplinary fines incurred by the Club on their behalf. This includes yellow and red cards and any other FFV imposed penalties for disciplinary misconduct. No member will be permitted to play until the Club has been reimbursed for the cost of the fine and the resulting suspension (if any) has been served.
